

# Prayer Vigil Prayer Sheet

- Pray for the crisis of COVID-19 itself: that God, in His great mercy, would remove this terrible virus for His glory and our good; for our medical community serving on the front lines; for those who are presently ill with this virus and for those families who have lost loved ones (including some in our FEB Central community); for those impacted in so many ways by the restrictions and lock downs (the unemployed, the poor, our children, those struggling with mental health issues, small business owners forced to close, etc...)
- Pray for our political leaders as they make difficult decisions during this medical crisis. Pray for the salvation of those leaders who do not know the Lord – that God would use this time to draw men and women to Christ. (1 Timothy 2:1-4). Pray that our leaders would have wisdom to understand that churches are an essential instrument that God can use in the fight against the effects of COVID-19.
- Pray for our churches:
  - For unity: that in our differing conscience positions about how to address the crisis of COVID-19, that we will be careful to not judge each other's motives and intent and that we would show humility and grace to others as we have been shown grace by God (Romans 14:13).
  - That we will remain on mission for the gospel in these fragile days, making the most of every opportunity and pointing people to Jesus as the only hope for our lives and for our world.
  - That we will remain committed to the priority of the fellowship of God's people, even during this time that we are not able to meet. We can be grateful for the gifts (i.e., technology) God has given us to keep us connected now, but we long for the day when we can meet together again face to face.
  - Pray for our Pastors and Ministry leaders as they navigate the ever-changing restrictions and the continued responsibility to care for their people.
