1. Life of Abiding Faith vs. 1-8

2. Life of Ernest Prayer Vs. 9-18

Even during those times of deep anguish, when we choose to pour out our soul to God, we will find new peace with ourselves and with our circumstances; a peace that only God can provide for us.

Questions:

- Hannah asked God to look upon her sorrow, and He did. What does it mean to you that the Creator of the universe cares about you enough to answer your prayers?
- What avenues do we sometimes take instead of taking our heartbreak and desperation to the Lord? Why turn to God first?

- What do you find most difficult about letting go and relying on God through prayer?

3. Life of Worship Vs. 21-28

After pouring out her soul in prayer, Hannah then responds with worship in her barrenness; trusting God in how He will answer her prayers, and remaining committed to God by fulfilling her vow of giving her son Samuel to serving Him for his whole life.

After pouring out our soul in prayer, we respond in worship in those moments of anguish; trusting God in how He will answer our prayers and remaining committed to Him through living a life that brings Him glory.

Question:

- What ways do you worship God that display your complete trust in Him?
